



PARTITION NOTES

1. THE DRAWING IS TO BE READ IN CONJUNCTION WITH ARCHITECTURAL, MECHANICAL AND ELECTRICAL SPECIFICATIONS. REFER DISCREPANCIES TO THE ARCHITECT FOR CLARIFICATION.
2. CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR FIELD MEASUREMENTS AND DIMENSIONS. REPORT DISCREPANCIES TO THE ARCHITECT IMMEDIATELY UPON DISCOVERY.
3. WORK IS TO BE CARRIED OUT ACCORDING TO RELEVANT CODES, STANDARDS AND AS PER THE RELEVANT SPECIFICATIONS.
4. CONTRACTOR MUST OBTAIN CONSTRUCTION PERMITS REQUIRED BY RELEVANT AUTHORITIES BEFORE THE COMMENCEMENT OF WORK.
5. DIMENSIONS ARE TAKEN FROM FACE OF FINISHED PARTITION TO FACE OF FINISHED PARTITION UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED.
6. DIMENSIONS TAKEN FROM THE CORN, COLUMNS OR CONNECTORS ARE TAKEN FROM THE FACE OF THAT ARCHITECTURAL ELEMENT TO THE CENTRE OF THE PARTITION.
7. ALL PARTITIONS TO BE FINISHED WITH A FINISH OF THE SAME TYPE, PARTITIONS TO BE FINISHED, SAVED SMOOTH AND MADE READY TO RECEIVE FINISHES.
8. DRYWALL PARTITIONS ARE TO BE SMOOTH AND PLUMB LINE FINISH.
9. CONTRACTOR TO ENSURE WALL PARTITION THICKNESS TO COORDINATE WITH DOOR THICKNESS. REFER DISCREPANCIES TO THE ARCHITECT IMMEDIATELY UPON DISCOVERY.
10. CONTRACTOR TO ENSURE SUFFICIENT BOLLINGS IS PROVIDED IN AREAS REQUIRING SUPPORT OF THE PARTITION OR CLANGING FOR MOUNTED EQUIPMENT OR MATERIALS.
11. CONTRACTOR TO PROVIDE PLUMB LINE FINISH TO ALL PARTITIONS. PARTITIONS TO BE FINISHED, SAVED SMOOTH AND MADE READY TO RECEIVE FINISHES.
12. CONTRACTOR TO PROVIDE SUFFICIENT BOLLINGS TO BE LOCATED TO PERMIT TO FURNISH PLUMB LINE FOR CABINET LAYOUTS.
13. CONTRACTOR TO REPAIR DAMAGE TO EXISTING FINE SEPARATION WITHIN THE AREA OF WORK.
14. CONTRACTOR TO ENSURE ARCHITECTURAL DRAWINGS TO ENSURE PROVISION FOR AIR FLOWER OPENINGS ABOVE AND BELOW PARTITION CONNECTIONS.
15. CONTRACTOR TO ENSURE ADEQUATE CHALKING IS PROVIDED AT PARTITION CONNECTIONS TO CHALK, CORN, FINISHED CLANG, FLOOR SLAB AND U/S OF PARTITION.
16. MATERIALS USED SHALL BE NEW UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED.
17. LOCATING WHERE EACH BUILDING PARTITION OR COLUMN ARE TO RECEIVE ELECTRICAL, CONDUIT AND BOLLING, DRYWALL CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR TURNING, LUGGING, LOCATING AND FINISHING AS PER ALL SPECIFICATIONS AT COMPLETION OF ELECTRICAL WORK.
18. REFER TO ARCHITECT'S PLUMB DRAWINGS FOR ALL PARTITION TYPES, PARTITION AND COLUMN CONNECTIONS.

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
